Curbside Clean-up Rules

May 2nd & 3rd South of 6th Ave SE

May 4th & 5th North of 6th Ave SE

May 6th John Rian

Please have items neatly placed on the curb before 8:00am the first day of clean up in your neighborhood. Late items will not be picked up.

Accepted materials

The following items will be accepted at the curb:

Appliances:

Water heaters, microwaves, washers, dryers, stoves, dehumidifiers, dishwashers, trash compactors, garbage disposals.

Fridges, Freezers, Air Conditioners and Water Chillers will only be picked up if they are tagged that the Freon has been removed.

All appliances need to have the doors removed or tie securely shut. **NO Food Product.**

BUNDLED BRUSH

Tree branches need to be parallel to curb so loaders can easily drive up and load them. Branches and logs need to be under 6'.

Carpets/carpet pads

Roll up carpets and carpet pads and tie them securely to easily be loaded.

Construction materials (lumber, windows, doors)

Lumber must be stacked.

Remove or bend nails.

General junk:

Boxed or bundled with twine - under 100 pounds per item.

Scrap Metal: swing sets, barbecue grills, bikes, treadmills, lawn mowers, snow blowers.

Drain any oil, gas and other fluids and remove rubber tires.

Mattresses/box springs:

Unusable furniture

Chairs, couches and sofas, etc.

Disassemble and separate hide-a-beds.

Materials NOT accepted at the curb:

The following items will NOT be collected by Curbside Cleanup crews.

Construction items:

No construction materials from businesses or contractors.

No railroad ties, concrete, bricks, shingles.

No asbestos.

Electronics:

No TVs, computers, printers, stereos, cell phones etc.

Exceptionally heavy and bulky items

No heavy or bulky items such as pianos or organs.

Hazardous waste:

No paints, motor oil, solvents.

No fluorescent tubes and bulbs.

No propane tanks.

No household chemicals.

No tires, or batteries.
